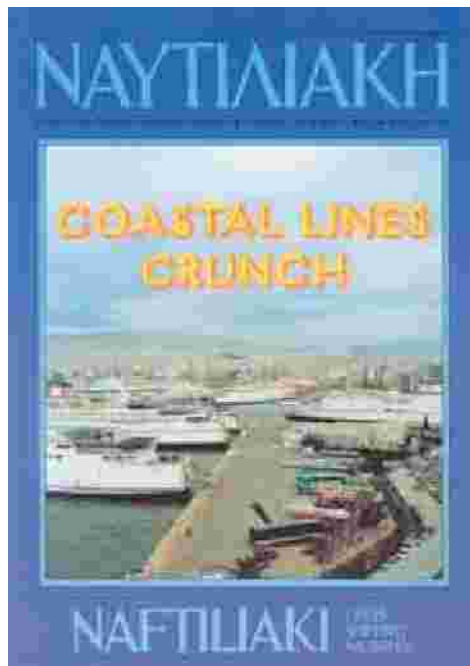

## PRESENTATION

AN ABSORBING introduction to FINANCIAL FUTURES, and the opportunities they can offer for hedging of highly volatile interest rates on Eurodollar and other loans, was provided for the shipping community in a December 8 seminar organised by the FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO in the Athens Chandris Hotel. Two or three of the largest names in Greek shipping were among companies who sent senior executives along to attend the three-hour session, and an alert audience of 60 also included brokers and top men from the accountancy world.
